Hello PCUMC Family,

As part of our STAND message series, we're journeying through the book of 1 Peter. Each week I'm sharing a memory verse for us to "chew on" and carry with us throughout the days ahead.

This week's verse from Sunday is:

"Love covers a multitude of sins." ~1 Peter 4:8b

In other words, love calls us to overlook one another's faults, to let go of offenses, and to forgive. Love covers, heals, and unites us in Jesus' name.

In a world full of noise and distraction, storing Scripture in our hearts like this helps us stay rooted in truth and peace - not just when we're gathered in church or reading our Bibles, but also in the quiet, ordinary moments of daily life.

Dallas Willard once said that memorizing Scripture is one of the most powerful ways we can be transformed into Christlikeness. When we internalize the Scriptures, it shapes how we think, speak, and respond to the world. As he put it,

"As we fill our minds with great passages of Scripture, our whole being becomes poised to act as Christ would act."

Memorizing Scripture isn't just about recalling words; it's about letting the Holy Spirit write truth on our hearts so that in moments of need, these words come alive within us. Here are a few examples from 1 Peter that you might find encouraging:



- When we're anxious: "Cast all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you." (1 Peter 5:7)
- When we feel wronged: "Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult." (1 Peter 3:9)
- When we need to remember our identity: "You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood..." (1 Peter 2:9)

As you commit verses like these to memory, over time they become part of who you are - a quiet conversation between your heart and God's.

Helpers are needed to set up, clean up and serve Holy Communion for the 10:45 service. Communion is shared the first Sunday of the month.


Greeters are also needed for the Blended Service.




