

Hello PCUMC Family,

Last Sunday we began our "Knocking On Heaven's Door" message series where we said the biblical story is not about how we get to heaven, it's about how heaven gets to earth and that the New Testament never uses the word heaven as a place where God's people go after their death for their long term future. This Sunday during our message we will take a biblical look at Hell and the relevance it has for our lives today. I think we might find a few surprises.

I wonder, however, what scripture references from last Sunday speak to you this week? What is God saying to you?

- Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me (Jesus in John 14:1).
- Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day (2 Corinthians 4:16).
- I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us (Romans 8:18).
- Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent (John 17:3).
- (God) will wipe every tear from their eyes. Death will be no more; mourning and crying and pain will be no more . . . (Revelation 21:4).
- So we make it our goal to please Him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it (2 Corinthians 5:9).

We can be people of hope because God's good purposes for our lives and THIS world will prevail! That reminds me. It has been said, "Hope is the ability to hear the music of the future. Faith is the courage to dance to it today." Anyone feel like dancing?

May Lesson topics - "PRAISE MAKERS: We Worship God Together in Different Ways"



This month, things will look a little different as the school year comes to an end and summer begins. As noted above, the only regularly scheduled gathering will be May 18.


